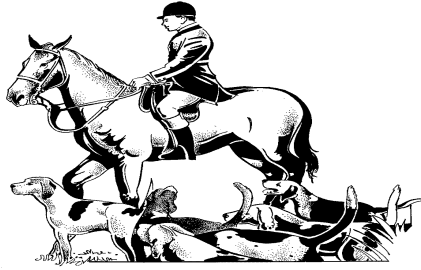

TARANAKI HUNT TREK 2019

The Taranaki Hunt warmly welcomes all riders and their horses to our 2019 trek at "Maxwell Family's coastal station, Mangapapa". We look forward to sharing three days of fantastic riding and breath-taking scenery with all those that join us.

Where to go,

Mangapapa is about 2.5 hrs from New Plymouth traveling north, turning left near the Awakino Service Station onto Manganui Road. Follow this road for approx 45 mins, then turn left onto Waikawau Road. **We will have trek signs out when approaching turn onto property.**

Timetable

You are welcome to arrive on the Thursday afternoon or evening prior to the trek. **Start time on the Friday will be 10.30am sharp, so be early.**

If you wish to stay a night in New Plymouth before or after the trek let us know as we can arrange accommodation for riders and horses.

Self Catering – Bring your own food and drink for the whole weekend.

We provide BBQs, hot & cold water, toasters, Marquee, toilets etc. We will also have **limited** refrigeration space for perishables, but please bring your own fridge or large chilly bins. There is a cold shower available or swim in the river right next to parking area – horses can swim also.

Saturday Night: Join us for pre-dinner bubbles and nibbles on us a good chance to have a good catch up with everyone always a fun time!!!

Entertainment: Juke box will be provided

THINGS TO BRING:

Food & drink including lunches, water bottle & lunch pack for saddle bags. All your horse and riding gear (including **spare horse shoes**), halter & lead for tying at lunch (baling twine supplied), all your horse feed, tent for sleeping, air bed, sleeping bag etc, deck chair, tea towel, togs and towels, spoon, knife and fork, plates, cup and glass, drink bottle, saddle blankets with pockets for your lunch, personal 1st aid supplies. Sunscreen & insect repellent (for humans & horses – there is a slight possibility of ticks, we recommend Ripcord or similar).

Some cash for emergencies, e.g. there is a **limited** farrier service available and some basic emergency veterinary supplies at your expense.

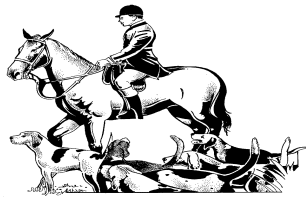
Riding Marshals

It is with the generosity of the property owners and management that we have permission to ride on this land.

When in camp, please remember that you are staying on privately owned land. Your respect and utmost care are required at all times. If you have a horse that may kick, please ensure there is a red ribbon in its tail. Do not tie horses directly to fences or rails without baling twine.

Trekking fee: \$180 for 3 days or \$60 a day if paid in full by Jan 27th – 10% extra for late payment

Your completed registration and a deposit of \$60 must be paid by the 10th January 2019 to secure your place on the trek. WE HIGHLY RECOMMEND EARLY REGISTRATION AS NUMBERS ARE LIMITED.
